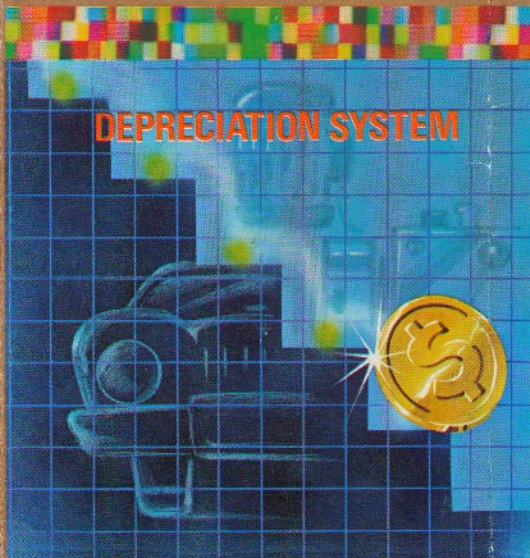

HOW TO LOAD AND RUN YOUR CREATIVISION SOFTWARE

Chapter 12 of your CREATIVISION BASIC manual explains all the steps necessary to load, run and save programmes of cassette tape with your CREATIVISION computer system. But just as a quick refresher course, here is a brief summary.

1. Make sure the Creativision cassette recorder is connected to your CREATIVISION computer. (Hook-up procedure is described in the Cassette Storage Module manual.)
2. Load the programme tape into the recorder and rewind the tape to it's starting position.
3. Type CRUN on your computer keyboard, then press the PLAY button on the Cassette Storage Module.
4. Press the RET'N key on your keyboard. The tape will begin to turn and the programme will begin loading into the computer.
5. When loading has finished, the tape will stop automatically.
6. If the tape contains more than one programme, the next programme will begin loading immediately after you have finished with the programme which is now in the computer. (NOTE: When another programme is loaded, the first is automatically erased from computer memory.)

Depreciation System

A ready tool for the executive, this application package saves you hours of rote calculation and data entry.

You only key in the relevant facts about the particular piece of equipment you're interested in and the programme does the rest.

It offers you a choice of analyses:

- 1) Depreciation rate:** Which is the figure, expressed in a percentage, which the equipment is losing in value for any particular year.
- 2) Depreciation amount:** Which expresses, in actual dollars and cents, the loss in value during a particular year.
- 3) Salvage value:** Which tells you, in dollars and cents, exactly how much your piece of equipment is worth on the open market right now, or at any specified time in the future.
